wont be anything impossible once he complete the race and experience his limit, and he became the iron man with his strong belief.



After that, President Yu participates triathlon annually, and appointed as a Chairman of Korean Triathlon Federation in 2000, chairman of Asian Triathlon Federation and Chairman of Sports and Environment and a member of executive committee of Olympic Council of Asia. He actively participates activities in international sports. He was also the Vice President of International Triathlon Union (2008-2012).
